

EDENHOPE COLLEGE EXAM POLICY

Examinations for senior students at Edenhope College will have the following structure.

Year 12: exams as prescribed by the Victorian Curriculum and Assessment Authority; and a formal practice exam period (including exam preparation) during the first three weeks of Term 4, for all subjects that have examinations at the end of the year, in a format the same as that on the end of year paper.

Year 11: exams of up to two hours for all Year 11 studies (or at least those that are externally examined in Year 12) twice – in the middle of the year and at the end of the year. **Exams** should reflect Year 12 practice in scope and structure.

Year 10: examinations in English and Mathematics at mid-year (and any one semester subjects), and end of year exams in all subjects (optional for electives only), ranging from 30 or 45 minutes in length up to one or one and a half hours. Exams that are conducted within normal timetabled classes are acceptable.

All teachers are to be aware of this and prepare accordingly.

REVIEW CYCLE
